

# General Rules of the Family Events Performance Series

## Credential Information - Participant entry fee includes:

Two (2) wristbands (for you and 1 passenger), a window sticker for your vehicle (must be displayed on the driver's side of the windshield), a dash plaque and a goodie bag. Your entry also covers any children 15 years old and younger that ride in your vehicle onto the show grounds. New starting in 2009, you will not need the child's wristband, the checkpoint entry will qualify any passengers, and determine the need to purchase extra tickets.

## Legal age of Participants:

All participants must be at least 18 years of age with a valid driver's license to enter a vehicle in the show. If a participant is under 18, a parent or legal guardian must sign a Parental Release Form.

## Picking up your credentials:

Bring your valid drivers license and insurance information to the registration trailer to sign and receive all credentials. Because you will need to sign the Liability and Photo releases, only the registered participant can pick up their credentials.

## Participant Refund Policy:

If you find at the last minute you cannot attend this show, we'll gladly issue a refund. You must contact us **IN WRITING no later than two (2) weeks following this year's event**, for this offer to be valid. Phone calls **DO NOT** qualify as notification. **Sorry, we no longer will transfer your entry to another show, or to next year!**

## General Show Information

### Participant Conduct:

Family Events reserves the right to restrict each and every participant to acceptable behavior during any and all activities of the event. Event Management will under no circumstances tolerate any of the following: drunkenness, public nudity, burnouts, recklessness, foul language, Mardi Gras beads or fighting by anyone on the premises. The "Spring Break" attitude will not be tolerated! There will be a **ZERO TOLERANCE** policy on disruptive behavior at all events. As well as conduct at the show, we expect your conduct outside the show to also be appropriate. Family Events reserves the right to pull your show credentials for any inappropriate conduct inside or outside of the show.

**Remember we are guests in someone else's city, please be respectful!**

### Participant Amenities:

Participants are allowed to bring coolers into the show in their vehicle for food and soft drinks. We ask that **NO GLASS BOTTLES** be brought into the fairgrounds. Drinks in aluminum cans should be put into a can cooler or a cup. **Beverages or coolers will not be allowed to be carried into the grandstand area.** Please remember spectators **ARE NOT** allowed to bring food or drink into the fairgrounds, so please be considerate in this matter. **The ONLY gate participants will be allowed to enter with coolers is the participant gate, NO ENTRY IS ALLOWED THROUGH A SPECTATOR GATE WITH COOLERS!**

### Personal Vehicles:

For safety reasons, the use of all personal means of transportation (bikes, scooters, golf carts, ATV's, motorcycles or minibikes, etc.) is forbidden on the fairgrounds on all show days and vendor set-up days.

### Handicap Vehicles:

Persons having their own three-wheeled electric unit may bring them, along with handicapped credentials, to the show office to obtain an authorized sticker for use at the show. Acceptable credentials include an official state permit, a handicapped license or a doctor's letter verifying need for handicapped unit. All privately owned three-wheeled handicap units are subject to approval. **Sorry, No Golf Carts.**

**No Animals Allowed On Grounds:** We do not allow animals into the event. This includes, but is not limited to dogs, cats, snakes, birds, etc. Please leave your pets at home or at the hotel, as we **WILL NOT** allow them into the event or on any part of the fairgrounds. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

### Participant Trailers:

Trailer show vehicles must be unloaded at registration or trailer parking and driven into the show.

**No trailers will be allowed to be driven into the fairgrounds at any time!**

### Vehicle Security at the show:

Security will be provided after registration hours on the day that on-site registration opens, continuing through the close of the show on Sunday, but you leave your vehicle and trailer at your own risk. Family Events does not guarantee the safety or security of any property left at any site at any time. We take reasonable measures to prevent theft or damage, but we do not guarantee it.
