What is the Hot Rod Magazine Power Tour? What vehicles are welcome on the Hot Rod Magazine Power Tour? Any car or truck owner who wants to join the tour is welcomed! Any year, make or model vehicle accepted. Please NO rental cars.

What is the price to enter the Hot Rod Magazine Power Tour? \$65 is the price for Pre-Registration, which ends Wednesday May 28, 2008. After that, registration can be done on site for \$75. For that price, you can be a long hauler and go the entire route, or pick up at any point and go on as many stops as you wish. What are the Hot Rod Magazine Power Tour Long Haulers and the Long hauler Awards? The Long Hauler awards ceremony will be held Saturday 6/14/08. These awards are to honor the Hot Rod owners that traveled the entire Power Tour route, checking in at the first stop in Little Rock, AR and going the entire route to Madison, WI.

Where do we start from every morning on the Hot Rod Magazine Power Tour? Each morning Tour participants are invited to meet back at the same facility the event was held at the previous day for a Driver's Meeting. Here, Tour participants will be informed of weather conditions, any delays or changes in the Tour route, etc. The Tour will then leave as one organized line of autos!
