

# Rock Crawl Challenge

All Rock Crawler competitors MUST be registered show participants.

**ROCK CRAWL Entry fee is \$20 for each class.** 100% payback to the top three places in each class. "Fun Runs" at no extra charge will be permitted as time allows.

## THE CLASSES:

**Stock:** Vehicle should be showroom stock. Wheelbase must be OEM. Must have roll bar or enclosed cab. Seat belts or harness required. Only modifications allowed are...up to and including 33 inch tires and no more than a 4 inch total lift.

**Modified Stock 1:** Up to and including 35" DOT tires. DOT tires only. No extended wheelbase. Steering and Frame must be OEM. Frame re-enforcements are allowed. Hydraulic assist is NOT allowed. Roll bar or cab required. Seat belts or harness required. No rear steering.

**Modified Stock 2:** 36" – 40" DOT tires. DOT tires only. No extended wheelbase. Steering and Frame must be OEM. Frame re-enforcements are allowed. Hydraulic assist is allowed. Roll bar or cab required. Seat belts or harness required. No rear steering.

**Open/Pro:** 35" and over tires. Includes all tube frame, coil overs and buggies. Rear steering allowed (one time penalty for use). Must be equipped with a winch. Seat belts or harness required. Must have roll cage. Lockers are recommended.

## GENERAL RULES

- Helmets are required, as are seat belts or harness.
- No passengers.
- The vehicle will be placed in the appropriate class. The vehicle will be allowed to run once per class (driver may be switched for Sunday)
- Spotter may spot only – no physical contact with the vehicle is allowed, other than hooking a winch cable to a winch point. Spotter cannot be attached to the vehicle by a tow line.
- Driver must remain in the vehicle at all times. Exiting the vehicle at any point is a disqualification.
- ALCOHOL PROHIBITED. Should a driver or spotter be suspected of such, vehicle will be disqualified with no refund given.
- All rules are subject to change
- Decision of the judges is final.

## THE COMPETITION:

### **Points:**

A point is equal to a minute

Stopping for more than a "5" count by Judge	1 pt (per 5 count)
Reversing course or backing up	1 pt
Touching a gate or cone	5 pts
Using a winch or other tool to aid progress	10 pts
Going through the gates out of order	20 pts
Missing a gate	20 pts
Leaving the designated course	DQ
Use of rear steering (open class only)	5 pts (1 x penalty)
Exceeding time limit	20 pts

(Time limit to be determined day of qualifying, based on course)
